Inland Empire Senate Scholarship Award Program

The TNBA Inland Empire Senate annually offers scholarships from the Inland Empire Senate Scholarship Fund (IESSF). IESSF was founded in 1993 with the purpose of assisting students of TNBA members with the cost incurred while enrolling into college. These scholarships are offered to local graduating high school seniors.

The number of annual awards and the amount of the awards is based on fund-raising and will be determined by the Executive Board of the Inland Empire Senate.

The Inland Empire Senate Scholarship Fund (IESSF) chair will provide scholarship applications to all local senates, tournament clubs, and interested parties. Qualifying students or their parents can only complete the application.

Procedures

1. Eligibility is restricted to students whose 1) parent(s) or guardian(s) are members of the Inland Empire Senate or 2) the student is a member of TNBA's Junior Program. Must be a member of Inland Empire Senate for at least two years.
2. Submission of the following documentation is required:
 - a) Special Student Attendance Form
 - b) Official Sealed Transcript
 - c) Essay
 - d) Letters recommendations from School Official, Senate member and community leader
3. All completed application must be submitted to the local Chairperson by March 15.
4. The local chairperson will evaluate all scholarship packets
