# THE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA TRI-SENATES TOURNAMENT RULES

1. The rules and information listed are important and should be read carefully before entry is completed. Entry forms not filled in properly and completely will be returned.
2. Entries for this tournament are open to members that belong to BOTH The National Bowling Association and USBC. Additionally, all applicants must be members of either the Southern California Tri-Senates or a guest that has been officially invited by The So. California Tri-Senates
3. No entries will be accepted after the closing date of the tournament.
4. Personal checks will not be accepted. Fees may be paid by bank checks, money orders, certified checks.
5. The tournament will be operated under strict compliance with TNBA and USBC rules.
6. **HANDICAP** for this Tournament will be **100% of 210** for each bowler. **HANDICAP** for this Tournament will be **100% of 210** for each bowler.
7. **Bowlers must use the higher of: (a) April 2011 book average of 21 games or more; (b) April 2010 book average of 21 games or more; (c) So. Cal Tri-Senate composite average since April 17, 2008 with a minimum of 15 games as of November 1, 2011. If no average for the last two seasons and no Tri Senate Composite average, bowler must use 210. USBC rules 319a-2 and 319d are waived for this tournament. Rules 319a-3 and 319e apply.**
8. This is a multiple team participation tournament. No more than three (3) bowlers can compete together more than once in a team event. Team composition can be any three-two combination.
9. A bowler whose high league average is 209 or less shall be subject to being re-rated and in such a case, he or she shall be notified and re-rated before the start of the tournament in accordance with USBC rule 319c.
10. **NO REFUNDS.** Fees after being received will not be refunded except in dire emergency, such as an employees strike, employees lockout, fire, acts of God, or anything else management has no control over.
11. One hundred percent (100%) of prize fund will be returned. There will be at least one prize for every eight entries. The Tournament Committee shall prepare the prize list after the entries are closed and the same shall be posted at the bowling lanes where the tournament is being conducted.
12. Unofficial tournament results will be distributed within 7 days after the completion of the event. If no discrepancies are made, the official tournament results and prize fund will be distributed within 14 days after the completion of the tournament. Brackets and side pots will be paid the same day of the tournament, immediately after competition. Once paid all results are final.
13. No hats or caps allowed during tournament play.
14. Tournament Committee reserves the right to disqualify any bowler not in compliance with the rules of the tournament.
15. Prizes, Championships will be determined by the greatest total of handicap pin fall.
16. Substitutes will be allowed. Once a substitute starts to bowl, he/she must complete all three games.
17. Each team member participating in the Tri-Senate match portion of the tournament (match play only) must wear the approved senate shirt of their membership senate. Failure to do so will result in not being allowed to bowl in that portion of the tournament. (match play only)
18. Each participant must compete for the senate they received their membership from for teams entered as Tri-Senate match teams. The only exceptions will be for last minute substitutes on the day of the tournament & approved by the tournament directors. Substitute scores from a different senate will not count towards the senate's totals.
19. Teams not entered as Tri-Senate match teams may have a makeup or mix of participants from any senate.
20. The total number of entries submitted by each of the three senates will be the same. The limitation on the total number of lanes available at the host bowling center will determine how many teams may be accepted by each senate. A senate may elect to use a qualifying round or other methods to determine which teams are officially submitted by that senate in the event they have more entries than allowed.
21. The Senate champion will be determined by the greatest total of handicap pin fall from sum of all the teams submitted by each senate
22. **SWEEPERS –**
  - **Bowlers may cash only once with the same person regardless of squad.**
  - **All bowlers may pay a \$30.00 fee to crossover with bowlers in any additional squad. Crossover pot will include bowlers in men, women, & mixed doubles and will be a stand alone (separate) pot.**
